Explanation

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact. The amendment expands ballot access for minor parties if a candidate nominated by that party for state office received at least 1% of the vote in the last election, or if in 47 state representative or state senate contests the minor party's candidates received at least 1% of the vote. This results in no fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.
