OFA Fiscal Note

See Fiscal Note Details

The amendment requires the State Department of Education (SDE) and the Department of Children and Families (DCF) to jointly request the U.S. Department of Education to authorize DCF to be an educational entity under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and prevents the implementation of the bill until DCF is authorized. The amendment precludes the fiscal impacts of the bill until DCF is authorized. The requirement to request authorization has no fiscal impact to SDE or DCF, as it is anticipated they can meet the requirement with existing resources.

The preceding Fiscal Impact statement is prepared for the benefit of the members of the General Assembly, solely for the purposes of information, summarization and explanation and does not represent the intent of the General Assembly or either chamber thereof for any purpose.
