OFA Fiscal Note

Cost

The amendment requires a Department of Children and Families (DCF) representative be present at board of education truancy meetings, as well as make home visits promptly when a truant student's parent or guardian fails to schedule or attend such meeting. This results in a cost to DCF beginning in FY 27, as it is anticipated the agency lacks sufficient resources to meet these requirements and will need to hire additional staff. The extent of this cost is dependent on: (1) the number of truancy meetings called, and (2) the number of cases where DCF must make a home visit after a parent or guardian's failure to attend such meetings.
