OFA Fiscal Note

Cost

The amendment requires the Department of Children and Families (DCF) to conduct a home visit for all truant students, resulting in a cost to the agency beginning in FY 27. It is anticipated DCF lacks sufficient capacity to conduct these visits and will need to hire additional staff. The exact cost is dependent on the number of truant students,¹ and the extent to which the home visits result in DCF investigations or involvement that would not have otherwise occurred.
