Explanation

The amendment requires the Office of the Governor (OTG) to identify scholarship granting organizations in the state under Public Law 119-21 and provide that information to the federal Secretary of the Treasury by December 31, 2026. This results in a cost to OTG of one position at a salary cost of \$33,000² in FY 27, with an associated fringe cost of \$14,000, to support a durational Fiscal Administrative Assistant. The additional position is required because there is no existing list of organizations that qualify and OTG would need additional resources to compile one.

¹The fringe benefit costs for most state employees are budgeted centrally in accounts administered by the Comptroller. The estimated active employee fringe benefit cost associated with most personnel changes is 41.82% of payroll in FY 27.

² The salary cost reflects the expected conclusion of the position by January 1, 2027.
