OFA Fiscal Note

Potential Cost

The amendment requires the Department of Children and Families (DCF) (rather than the school district) to notify families whether a student withdrawal attempt is effective, and if not, the reason why. This results in a potential cost to DCF beginning in FY 28 as it is anticipated the agency lacks sufficient resources to make such notifications and may need to hire additional staff. In certain situations, staff may need to make multiple attempts to contact families in addition to other required duties. The number of staff hired will vary based on the number of students subject to the withdrawal framework.
