OFA Fiscal Note

No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

Section 1 requires the Connecticut Agricultural Experiment Station (CAES) to submit a report on various issues related to sterile cultivars and does not result in a fiscal impact to CAES.

Section 2 makes a procedural change to the application process for certain solid waste and does not result in a fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.
