The amendment strikes the language of the underlying bill and the associated fiscal impact.

The amendment, which makes technical, clarifying, and conforming changes to the Department of Developmental Services' (DDS) procedures, reporting requirements, and training guidelines for abuse and neglect investigations, is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the state.
