No Fiscal Impact

The amendment creates a task force to study and identify the causes and factors contributing to the decrease in traffic stops and enforcement of motor vehicle violations in the state since 2018 and the increase in traffic accidents, injuries, and fatalities during such time period, resulting in no fiscal impact because the task force has the expertise to meet the bill's requirements.
