No Fiscal Impact

The amendment alters the circumstances when the Attorney General can investigate, intervene in or bring a civil or administrative action and does not alter the fiscal impact in the underlying bill.

The amendment also allows the Division of Criminal Justice (DCJ) or the Inspector General to bring an action in the Superior Court under certain circumstances, resulting in no fiscal impact because the affected agencies have the expertise and capacity to meet the amendment's requirements.

The amendment also provides that DCJ may not access certain scenes until fully secured and deemed safe which is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact as this change is largely procedural.

The preceding Fiscal Impact statement is prepared for the benefit of the members of the General Assembly, solely for the purposes of information, summarization and explanation and does not represent the intent of the General Assembly or either chamber thereof for any purpose.
