The amendment strikes sections 1 and 2 of the underlying bill which eliminates any fiscal impact associated with these sections.

Sections 1 and 2 make various changes to the Local Capital Improvement Program (LoCIP) and the Small Town Economic Assistance Program.

The amendment does not impact the underlying fiscal impact associated with sections 4 and 5 of the bill.
