OFA Fiscal Note

Reduces Cost In Bill

The amendment eliminates a provision that expanded the existing business case requirements under the privatization law, which reduces the cost in the bill. The cost reduction is associated with reduced requirements to complete a business case under current law. The exact cost reduction will vary by agency and depend on the number of analyses subject to the privatization law, which will no longer require additional analyses.

In addition, the elimination of the additional responsibilities for various state agencies will eliminate the bill's cost to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS), which was \$424,075 in FY 27 and \$224,075 in FY 28 (and annually thereafter), including two new positions.
