### ***OFA Fiscal Note***

#### ***Eliminates Cost In Bill***

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact, and results in the fiscal impact outlined below.

The amendment requires the Secretary of the State to convene a working group to study the potential expansion of the address confidentiality program, resulting in no fiscal impact on the state or municipalities. The working group has the necessary expertise to complete the provisions of the amendment.
