The amendment reduces the potential savings to the Department of Correction and the potential cost to the board of Pardons and Paroles in the underlying bill by removing a rebuttal presumption that a person seeking parole has satisfied certain parole eligibility factors, thereby potentially reducing the number of individuals released for parole under the bill.
