"AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATUTE OF LIMITATION FOR INJURY CAUSED BY FRAUD IN THE PROVISION OF FERTILITY CARE AND TREATMENT."

3 "(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 52-577 of the general
4 statutes, a patient may bring an action to recover damages for personal
5 injury caused by fraud in the provision of fertility care and treatment
6 not later than thirty years from the date on which the child born as a
7 result of fraud in the provision of fertility care attains the age of twenty-
8 one.

9 (c) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 52-577 of the general
10 statutes, a child born as a result of fraud in the provision of fertility care
11 may bring an action to recover damages for personal injury caused by
12 such fraud when the injury is a serious genetic disorder, harmful
13 physical condition or harmful emotional condition occurring as a result

14 of the fraud. Such action shall be brought not later than thirty years from
15 the date on which the child born as a result of fraud in the provision of
16 fertility care attains the age of twenty-one."
