"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF PARENT-MANAGED LEARNING."

1 Strike section 2 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Sec. 2. (*Effective July 1, 2026*) (a) Not later than July 1, 2027, the
3 Department of Education shall develop the intent to educate form and
4 withdrawal form, as such forms are described in section 10-184 of the
5 general statutes, as amended by this act. The department shall submit
6 such forms to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
7 having cognizance of matters relating to education for review and
8 approval or rejection in accordance with the provisions of subsection (b)
9 of this section. If the joint standing committee approves such forms, the
10 department shall make such forms available to local and regional boards
11 of education.

12 (b) Not later than thirty days following receipt of the intent to educate
13 form and the withdrawal form, submitted pursuant to subsection (a) of
14 this section, the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
15 having cognizance of matters relating to education shall hold a public
16 hearing on such forms. The committee shall provide an opportunity for
17 the public to comment on such forms. Following such public hearing,
18 the committee shall vote to approve or reject such forms. If the
19 committee rejects such forms, the Department of Education shall have
20 thirty calendar days to develop new intent to educate and withdrawal
21 forms and resubmit such new forms for a public hearing and approval
22 or rejection in accordance with this subsection."
