**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF PARENT-MANAGED LEARNING."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2026*) Not later than January 1, 2028, the  
4 Commissioners of Education and Children and Families and the  
5 executive director of the Court Support Services Division of the Judicial  
6 Branch shall jointly develop a plan to reestablish truancy courts in the  
7 state. The commissioners and executive director shall submit such plan  
8 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having  
9 cognizance of matters relating to education, children and the judiciary,  
10 in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general  
11 statutes."
