**"AN ACT CONCERNING VARIOUS REVISIONS TO HUMAN SERVICES STATUTES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2026) (a) The Commissioner of  
4 Social Services shall increase the asset limit for the HUSKY C health  
5 program, as defined in section 17b-290 of the general statutes, for (1) an  
6 unmarried person from one thousand six hundred dollars to five  
7 thousand dollars, and (2) married persons from two thousand four  
8 hundred dollars to seven thousand five hundred dollars.

9 (b) Not later than July 1, 2027, the commissioner shall file a report, in  
10 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,  
11 with the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having  
12 cognizance of matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of state  
13 agencies, human services and aging on (1) the number of persons

14 eligible for the HUSKY C health program for the prior fiscal year, and  
15 (2) any increased costs incurred by the state that are attributable to  
16 changes in the asset limits."
