**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROVISION OF PARENT-MANAGED LEARNING."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a task force  
4 to study and make recommendations concerning issues relating to the  
5 provision of parent-managed learning in Connecticut. For purposes of  
6 this section, "parent-managed learning" means the provision of  
7 education that is managed by a parent or guardian of a child in a setting  
8 other than a public school or nonpublic school.

9 (b) The task force shall consist of the following members:

10 (1) One appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives;

11 (2) One appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate;

12 (3) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of  
13 Representatives;

14 (4) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate;

15 (5) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of  
16 Representatives;

17 (6) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate; and

18 (7) The Commissioner of Education, or the commissioner's designee.

19 (c) Any member of the task force appointed under subdivision (1),  
20 (2), (3), (4), (5) or (6) of subsection (b) of this section may be a member  
21 of the General Assembly.

22 (d) All initial appointments to the task force shall be made not later  
23 than thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy shall  
24 be filled by the appointing authority.

25 (e) The speaker of the House of Representatives and the president pro  
26 tempore of the Senate shall select the chairpersons of the task force from  
27 among the members of the task force. Such chairpersons shall schedule  
28 the first meeting of the task force, which shall be held not later than sixty  
29 days after the effective date of this section.

30 (f) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the  
31 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to education  
32 shall serve as administrative staff of the task force.

33 (g) Not later than January 1, 2027, the task force shall submit a report  
34 on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee of  
35 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to  
36 education in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the  
37 general statutes. The task force shall terminate on the date that it  
38 submits such report or January 1, 2027, whichever is later."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
