1. JJPOC Spotlight Discussion and Prep

- This workgroup has started off the presentations to the JJPOC and agencies are now lining up to present
- The agencies that have already presented are Youth Service Bureau and the CSD
- The agencies that are going to present next are:
- Doctor Worthy on the Juvenile Justice Education Unit in May
- Rocca, Compass, CJR, Project longevity and CPA in June
- DCF in July
- DOC in September
- There is a request to be more specific on DOC's data and to understand the needs of young people and if we are meeting those needs

2. HHEJ Study Update

- The HHEJ is a multi-level examination of health, housing, and education indicators for DCF, and justice involve youth in young adults
- Conversations with some state agencies like Judicial Branch court support services division and court operations, DOC, DCF, OPM, and SDE to discuss the feasibility of the project. Additionally, the state agencies provided advice.
- Next step is to legally get permission to receive the data needed from the agencies.
- Dr. Cooper will be on sabbatical
- Next conversation is to find out how P21 can benefit the research
- Workgroup member provided an update on p21
- Court support services, DCF, CCH, and DOE are all going through one framework to review request and go through the MOA progress.

3. Equity Dashboard Update

- Dashboard did launch last JJPOC
- Currently working on First-time Felony, disposition, detention, delinquent referral, non-judicial handling to release soon on the website.
- Workgroup members are encouraged to spread the awareness of the Dashboard
- Tow will help to make an issue brief to spread awareness
- CCLP is willing to make a user guide so the public knows how to use it and so the dashboard can be easily acceptable
