JJPOC Diversion Workgroup December 11, 2020 11:00 AM-12:30 PM Zoom Conference Call

Meeting Summary:

- Update on Raising the Minimum Age Subgroup:
 - The workgroup discussed the process for referrals in crisis and non-crisis situations. The workgroup plans to work with the education committee of JJPOC for to draft a recommendation to call mobile crisis or other alternative systems instead of 911. The workgroup hopes to utilize collected data from 211 calls and 911 calls for the under 12 population. The Raising the Minimum Age subgroup will develop a process for schools to follow when calling either 211, 911 or a YSB. There was consensus that there needs to be plans to reeducate and inform schools about these alternatives and the process to make these calls.
- Presentation of Draft Implementation Plan for Raising the Minimum Age:
- Discussion & Feedback:
 - There was concern that the draft focuses more on accountability than on support for schools; the workgroup reached a consensus to revise this issue. There was also discussion on additional support services in school, police authorization for missing children cases, and implementation plan language.
 - There was also consensus in the workgroup to have this plan effective by July 1, 2021.
