Summary:

- **JJPOC Recommendations Update**

- Most recommendation are at a standstill until they see what passes
 - Raise the age is on a pause
 - Alternatives to Arrest is having pushback so that workgroup will be looking at Larceny 5 specifically
 - Truancy will remain a workgroup after this session
 - Alternatives to Arrest may be absorbed by overall Diversion workgroup if the addendum passes this session
 - Workgroup needs an update on Risk Based Handling

- **Next Steps**

- Workgroup wants to gather data to look at outcomes regarding Truancy and Chronic Absenteeism
 - This data is hard to look at because back at school is not necessarily the only success as other steps may need to occur before this one



- The data needs to give consistent results, therefore YSBs and the schools need to be using consistent language and definitions of especially chronic absenteeism
- Want to look at what resource's communities have access to
 - The group have a JRB list but not an overall public one
 - Could make a quick grid to fill out since they just did landscape analysis
 - Look more into questions on landscape analysis to see if this data can be derived
 - Want to look at ARPA funding in respect to YSB funding
 - Look at gaps in services between areas which potential require more ARPA funds
- The new data system will likely help to define successes more broadly for JRB and YSB Juveniles
- JJPOC was not able to vote at last meeting due to time constraints
- Noted that Rep. Nolan is pushing to Raise the Age to 12 and Rep. Gilchrest to age14
