- NCYL (Colorado) has created taskforce to assist youth in obtaining resources/services in the justice system
 - Discussion of diversion records
- Utah kids under 12 cannot be referred to court; can be referred to diversion services
 Attempt to make these records expunged
- Pennsylvania No updates
- Connecticut struggling to raise the minimum age to 12 y/o
 - Currently at 10 years old; was at 7 y/o
 - \circ All status offenses removed from court as of 2020
 - o In need of resources on justice reinvestment
- Michigan JJ Taskforce has been enacted
 - Raising the minimum age to 13; carve-outs possible
