Meeting Summary

1. Tasha Hunt – Juvenile Probation Risk Based Case Handling Pilot

- Looks more at risk rather than charge and what number of offenses
- Recidivism: Under 15% for tier 2 and under 5% for tier 1 so far

2. Review ticket book referral form

- The current system has confusion because some towns are using a ticket that makes it appear as though the Juvenile must appear in court
- There needs to be a way to track the number of offenses the juvenile has committed as these effects if they are diverted or not
 - Brief discussion regarding charges for possession
 - The possession workgroup is working on diversion for possession cases, it may be beneficial to work in conjunction with them
 - Discussion regarding ideas and language surrounding when diversion does not work
 - Decision to refer to next step is: referred for further action
 - Definitions of offenses to be included
 - TYJI will look into way to include this aspect
 - Need to add spot for other offense, so this form can be used more than just for the initiative
 - Address that this is an addendum to last year's act
 - 2174 act requirements from the group
 - Note that no new legislation had been passed based upon the recommendations
 - Updates regarding membership updates and work done since last session
 - Add updated data slides- use old slides but new data and offenses
 - Group to look over the offenses
 - Want to include data on outcomes to show impact
 - Will include implementation date



- Need to look at 7 factors that need to be considered in recommendations
 - Capacity (link landscape analysis)
 - Accountability Mechanisms
 - Recidivism
 - Victim input
 - Data collection
 - Communication and outreach
 - Implementation date
- Need to update age and lockup
 - Make section for legislative updates or notes- will discuss again
