## Meeting Summary:

- JJPOC Update
  - At the January JJPOC meeting, there was insufficient time to discuss and vote on the Education Committee Recommendations. They will now be presented and voted on at the February meeting.
- CCA Recommendation
  - At the January Incarceration Workgroup meeting, representation from the Center for Children's Advocacy proposed a recommendation that would require a PPT meeting for all special education youth in the justice system in advance of their transition back to their home community/school district.
    - The Incarceration Workgroup felt it was best to refer this recommendation to the Education Committee for consideration.
  - It was noted how important that both the discharging and receiving school districts should actively participate in these meetings and there should be individuals present with knowledge of the programmatic offerings in the receiving district.
  - Under current federal legislation, a PPT is theoretically required for all major changes in placement under the IDEA Act.
    - Placement in juvenile detention does not count as a change in placement unless the stay is 10+ days.
  - There was discussion of the importance of parent participation in the PPT meetings (at minimum by phone).
  - The members of the Committee emphasized how important it is that the receiving district actively participates.
  - The members of the Committee agreed to amend the recommendation to call for a PPT meeting at both entry and discharge of placement(s).
  - It was discussed to bring forth the entire recommendation to the JJPOC and leave out day requirements. Ultimately, it was decided that subsection 1 would remain in the recommendation, however, subsection 2 would be eliminated going forward.
- Next Steps
  - Kelly will update the recommendation's language per the Committee's request.
  - The updated language will be sent out to the JJPOC by email sometime next week.
