As the attached historical data reflects, in 2009 the normal retirement take rate was 44.1%, which resulted in over \$70 million in accrual payouts. A typical amount of General Fund accrual payouts each fiscal year is \$25 to \$30 million. Most agencies absorb all or at least part of the costs. What the agencies cannot absorb is paid from the RSA account.

The estimated total accrual payout if all employees eligible for a normal or early retirement is \$180,681,110.08. This estimate is, however, misleading as history reflects that not all employees with the requisite age and years of service will retire. We also do not know how many employees will elect early retirement. Furthermore, the estimate reflects the compensable leave time employees have now; we do not know how much compensable time they will have a year from now. Using the 2009 retirement take rate of 44.1%, we can anticipate accrual payouts to equal approximately \$79.7 million. The FY 22 recommended RSA includes an estimated carry forward of \$44.9 million plus a recommended appropriation of \$18.9 million for a total of \$63.8 million, which would be available after agencies fund accruals payouts from their available appropriation.

Question 4

Questions:

Could OPM provide a breakdown of state managers eligible to retire, and 2) accrete into a union?

Answers:

Part 1:

OPM provided a copy of a December 2, 2020 query of all Executive Branch employees by agency by retirement tier to Senator Osten, Representative Walker and Sue Keane on January 7, 2021 (see attached for a copy of the email). OPM can provide an electronic copy of this 937-page report if requested.

There are approximately 8,540 employees in the Executive Branch eligible to retire, of which 505 are managers. See next page for the following:

- Number of eligible managers to retire by agency
- Titles of eligible managers to retire by agency

Part 2:

A desk audit of the approximate 1,300 current state managers would be required to answer this question with any degree of accuracy.

The State Employee Relations Act provides the definition of a manager as follows:

Managerial employee means any individual in a position in which the principal functions are characterized by not fewer than two of the following, provided for any position in any unit of the system of higher education, one of such two functions shall be as specified in subdivision (4) of this subsection: (1) Responsibility for direction of a subunit or facility of a major division of an agency or assignment to an agency head's staff; (2) development, implementation and evaluation of goals and objectives consistent with agency mission and policy; (3) participation in the formulation of agency policy; or (4) a major role in the administration of collective bargaining agreements or major personnel decisions, or both, including staffing, hiring, firing, evaluation, promotion and training of employees.

The Labor Board has held that these must be primary functions of the job in order to meet the standard, and developing goals and formulating policy is typically not the major function of any manager's job because they are typically "working supervisors," performing similar or the same tasks as the employees they supervise and manage. The Board ruled that Deputy Wardens were not managers, and the State Police Lieutenants were not managers although they were in charge of facilities and districts respectively. They did not, however, as a "principal function," develop goals, implement policy, administer labor agreements or independently make personnel decisions. All or none of the remaining 1,300 managers could accrete depending upon the evidence, and what employees say they do. The determination as to which managers could accrete is fact specific.
