Budget Management Strategies

- Increase the Agency's Ability to analyze and share data so that resources, interventions and programs can be targeted and customized to maximize impact and effectiveness.
- Evaluate and align programs and grant funding to ensure the greatest impact on student success.
- Utilize the LEAN process to identify ways to more effectively and efficiently deliver services to school districts.
- Reorganize as necessary and redeploy staff to support agency priorities.
- Limit Hiring to refills of positions critical to achieving agency priorities.
- Require sustainability planning as an element in all grant programs for local school districts and CTHSS programming.
