Estimates for Fall 2024 based on CSCU data (fall 2024 enrollment data as of census, and preliminary estimates of FT and PT faculty headcounts provided by the institutions).

* CT State is the merger of 12 community colleges since July 2023.

IPEDS & CDS Methodology:

Report the Fall 2024 ratio of full-time equivalent students (full-time plus 1/3 part time) to full-time equivalent instructional faculty (full time plus 1/3 part time).

In the ratio calculations, exclude both faculty and students in stand-alone graduate or professional programs such as medicine, law, veterinary, dentistry, social work, business, or public health in which faculty teach virtually only graduate level students.

Do not count undergraduate or graduate student teaching assistants as faculty.
