Collaborative effort of Data sharing between the Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) and Judicial Branch – Court Support Services Division (CSSD)

The project goal is to make available a child's school record from the CSDE's data warehouse to Juvenile Probation Officers in a timely manner.

Effective June 22, 2016, <u>Juvenile Probation Officers have access to a School</u> <u>Summary Report</u> for clients with:

- an open case with Juvenile Probation,
- a Release of Information signed by the Parent/Guardian, AND
- a valid SASID # (10 digits).

This report allows Juvenile Probation Officers to <u>view historical data available</u> in the Connecticut State Department of Education data warehouse. Information from this warehouse is collected from public schools at certain time intervals throughout the school year.

While this data <u>may not reflect the most recent</u> educational events, it offers a simple and expedient way to retrieve a client's educational history. Juvenile Probation Officers at this time continue to need to contact the school for up-to-date information. As more data is added to the CSDE's data warehouse, this will become less necessary.
