CTRP3 Policy Work Group Draft Definition

"Officer-initiated pedestrian stop" means a detention of a pedestrian by a law enforcement officer, not associated with a call for service, when the detention results in a citation, an arrest, frisk, or search of the pedestrian's body or property. The term does not apply to detentions for routine searches performed at the point of entry to or exit from a controlled area and arrests or searches pursuant to a warrant issued by a court.
