## 2022 Diversion Workplan



- Truancy: update on previous JJPOC legislation on truancy, review truancy data, identify strategies to reengage students, and engage YSB for support services.
- Alternative to Arrest: reengage subgroup to establish plan for recommendation in 2023
- Raise the Minimum Age: reengage subgroup to establish plan for recommendations 2023
- YSB and JRB
  - Pilot of best practices across 7 YSB (screening, service matching, capacity, and data collection)
  - JRB Landscape analysis (operational procedures, gaps, strengths)

## 2022 RED Workplan



- Equity Dashboard: collaborate with OPM on the development and implementation of the Equity Dashboard.
- Pedestrian Stops/Racial Profiling Board: Collaborate with IMRP & OPM and establish plan for recommendations for 2023.
- City of Hartford Pilot: continue to work with City of Hartford on the implementation of the pilot. Feasibility of replication in other locations.
- SRO Subgroup: reengage meetings with law enforcement on MOU's, and engage CT Associate of Public School Superintendents.
- Center for Children's Advocacy: RED committees
- Center for Children's Law and Policy: providing technical assistance via OJJDP grant to the JJPOC RED workgroup.
