
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Purpose Statement Voting

At our last strategic planning meeting, we identified key purpose statements for our two main goals: **System Infrastructure and Services**

System Infrastructure Purpose Statement Options

Option 1

Build the capacity and coordination of the children's behavioral health infrastructure to increase the effectiveness of and access to services that meet family needs.

- **Effectiveness** refers to data, governance, oversight and accountability.
- **Access** refers to availability of a diverse set of services and trained service providers, the coordination of services, systematic knowledge, channels of communication, and funding for sustainability.

Option 2

Create a structure for children's behavioral health needs that utilizes data to drive sound strategic and operational decision making and provides resources across agencies to ensure that the needs of children and families are met both effectively and efficiently.

Option 3

Identify, enhance, and reform current and future children's behavioral health services with a community and family focus. These services should be derived from local community needs, informed by efficient and effective data-driven decisions, adequately resourced, and supported by a robust accountability structure.

Services Purpose Statement Options

Option 1

Provide comprehensive support to families by addressing the social, mental, and physical drivers of health through integration of services, the provision of appropriate services, and improved access to these services.

Option 2

Ensure statewide and local capacity and awareness to deliver a full continuum of affordable, integrated, coordinated, and individualized services to children, birth to 21, in the context of their families, caregivers, and communities.
