CTDOT Projects in Greater Mystic: Infrastructure

Highway and Bridge:

 Investing an estimated \$1 Billion by designing and constructing 22 projects within the Groton, New London, Stonington, North Stonington, Waterford municipalities.

22 Highway and Bridge Projects:

- 17: Bridge/Culvert improvements projects
- 2: Safety Improvements (I-95)
- I: Computerized Traffic Signal Systems (CTSS)Replacement
- 1: Intersection Improvement Rt 614 at I-95 ramps
- 1: On-Road Bicycle Improvements (Rt. 1 and Rt 649)

The purpose of this Project is to improve safety along I-95 Southbound by upgrading roadside protective measures to meet current design standards including new MASH compliant guiderail and roadway illumination. Additionally, per coordination with the Department's Pavement Design Unit, it was determined that the existing pavement structure is in a deteriorating condition and in need of rehabilitation.

Project 0058-0341: Intersection Improvements on Rt. 614 & I-95 Ramps

Project Location

This project is located on Route 614 (Allyn Street / Mystic Street) in the vicinity of Interstate 95 (Interchange 89) in the Town of Groton.

Purpose and Need

The purpose of this project is to improve safety and reduce queues by addressing the geometric and operational deficiencies along Route 614 at its intersections with the I-95 northbound and southbound ramps and Sandy Hollow Road.

Project 0058-0344: Replacement of Bridge 04675 (Palmer Cove, Groton)

Project Location

Groton Long Point Road over Palmer Cove

Anticipated Construction Completion Date	Spring 2026	Total Project Cost	\$8,535,000
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Purpose and Need

Bridge No. 04675 exhibits structural deficiencies. The deck is in poor condition (Rating = 4). The superstructure is also in poor condition (Rating = 4).

- Route 32 (Mohegan Ave) (New London): Completed 2016



CTDOT Projects in Greater Mystic: CCGP

Competitive Grant Program developed by the Connecticut DOT to provide construction funds to Municipalities for infrastructure improvements that improve safety and access for vulnerable roadway users

\$975,000 Awarded in New London, Groton and Stonington

- Connectivity Improvements at Governor Winthrop Boulevard, Water Street, and Ferry Street. (Signals, sidewalks, crosswalks) (New London): Finalizing Fall 2024
- Trolley Trail Extension (Groton): In-Design Sept. 2024
- Sidewalk ramp upgrade project (Stonington): In-design July 2024



CTDOT Projects in Greater Mystic: LOTCIP

The purpose of the LOTCIP is to provide State monies to urbanized area municipal governments instead of Federal funds otherwise available through the Federal transportation legislation.

I-95 Planning and Environmental Linkage (PEL)

Project Location

• This project is located along I-95 from Branford (Exit 53) to the Rhode Island state line.

Project Purpose

• The purpose of this project is to increase regional mobility and safety along Interstate 95 from Exit 53 in Branford to the Rhode Island state line.

Previous Studies conducted by SCCOG

- Southeastern Connecticut Regional Bike & Pedestrian Plan: Completed 2019
- Multiuse Path Feasibility Study: Published March 2021

CTDOT Projects in Greater Mystic: Overview

Ongoing Districtwide and Statewide Projects:

- Repair and replacement of bridge deck joints
- Sealing concrete bridges along I-95 bridges
- Installation and replacement of railroad markings & signs
- Installation of curve warning signs on locally owned and maintained public roadways
- Installation of curve warning signs on state owned and maintained public roadways
- Installation of high friction surface treatment (HFST) at select locations
- Installation of rapid rectangular flashing beacons at uncontrolled, midblock crosswalk locations
- Installation of rumble strips
- Installation of wrong way detection systems
- Installation and upgrades to accessible pedestrian systems
- Replacement of highway illumination systems
- Replacement of signs and sign supports on I-95
- Replacement and upgrade of existing pedestrian/school crossing at uncontrolled intersection and midblock crosswalks
- Replacement and upgrades of traffic control signals
- Replacement of highway signs along limited access portions of various roadways
- Signing and pavement marking installation at unsignalized state road intersections
- Traffic signal timing revisions
