Major cold weather events have occurred in 3 of the past 5 winters including the 2014 Polar Vortex and the 2018 Cold Snap

2018 Cold Snap – 13 Days of sub-freezing Temperature

- 2013/14 Polar Vortex winter increased gas demand, threatened reliability, and drove skyrocketing prices
- 2017/18 winter cold snap created similar disruptions
- No impact on gas distribution companies who procure gas through firm contracts
