The solar panels on my roof power our cars and run my house. And I've invested in PV systems on several commercial buildings in CT. Meanwhile the forest fires burn hotter, the destructive storms increase, and we jeopardize our future.

We urgently need expanded, simplified solar and wind incentives, including net-metering, storage, community solar, and feed in tariffs or ZREC programs. Unfortunately, the existing programs are so onerously complex, that they seem to have been designed by utility lobbyists.

And another fossil fuel pipeline would be wrong in every sense.

Please do better.
