Catherine Hulbert, Trumbull: Legislators, please go with mail-in ballots. Other states do it. Washington State, for one, has been using mail-in ballots for about nine years; the Republican Secretary of State says the number of "questionable" votes cast is negligible. And let's not kid ourselves: in-person voting is not a foolproof alternative, not in an age of hackers. I want to be able to avoid COVID-19 AND keep a copy of my ballot to guard against tampering. Absentee ballots ARE mail-in ballots. Let's make them available to all Connecticut residents. (
