has a genetic syndrome

that puts her at risk for complications should she be exposed to the virus. She has been voting for 11 years and she takes pride in her ability to do so. She also has an intellectual disability which will make it difficult to get her to understand not voting.

As you can imagine this issue is critical to the health and wellbeing of many citizens in our state.
