I could not leave my house in Willimantic and I couldn't visit my mother and father in Tolland. I missed Easter with my whole family, my father's 80th birthday, and a family reunion that was supposed to be in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina this week.

I have voted in every election since I was 18 years old and I want to vote in November 2020. But if COVID-19 gets bad again I will have to quarantine in my house again. Then I wouldn't be able to vote. I want to vote and I deserve to vote. Let me vote by Absentee Ballot in November 2020.
