Dear Government Oversight leadership,

The Town of Canton requests that the land conveyance passed during the 2024 legislative session in Special Act 24-20 be repealed. Although Canton maintains its desire to use the land, several abutting properties would have to go through the conveyance process to allow for use of the lot. Therefore, the Department of Energy and Environmental Protections has reached an agreement with the town to lease the property. To facilitate the deal, the repeal of the conveyance is required.

The Canton delegation hereby requests that the Government Oversight Committee raise a bill to repeal the land conveyance of 37 Bridge Street, as defined in [Special Act 24-20](#).
