GAP Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for GAP participation, students must:

- Enroll in and complete a liberal arts associate degree transfer program or other approved program at a Connecticut community college
- Submit a GAP Application to UConn before completion of 30 transferable credits of study at any Connecticut community college
- Complete appropriate community college courses, as approved by GAP advisor
- Maintain a minimum grade point average as required by UConn's school or college

Consult with individual community college advisors for further information and assistance in selecting courses that will meet both community college and UConn degree requirements.
