All staff are required to take an online sexual harassment course annually. Students are sent a link to the policies annually, the policies are in our online catalog, there is a link to the "Not AnyMore" video in our learning management system that all students taking courses have access to. Faculty are also sent a link to our policies annually. We have not had any cases of reported sexual violence in 2019. The Annual Security Report is available on our website, which includes the reporting requirements, definitions, policies, number and type of incidents, etc..
