Act 14-11 Progress Narrative

During the calendar year 2021, QVCC continued its efforts to fully implement the provisions of the Connecticut Public Act 14-11, "An Act Concerning Sexual Assault, Stalking, and Intimate Partner Violence on Campus"; and the new requirements of the "Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998." QVCC is committed to fulfilling its duty under these laws to provide a safe environment for students, faculty, staff, and visitors to the College.

Building upon the College's 2020 efforts, the changes to sexual misconduct case reporting, and investigating processes that were instituted by the Department of Education in Summer of 2020, QVCC has further strengthened its compliance infrastructure. QVCC continues to partner with the Sexual Assault Crisis Center of Eastern Connecticut (SACCEC) to provide assistance, advocacy, emotional support, and counseling to victims of sexual violence. The College also continues its partnership with United Services, INC. to provide similar support services for victims of domestic violence. Both third party vendors provide services to victims with the highest level of confidentiality allowed under the State and Federal laws. Support services by the third-party vendors are accessible to victims by telephone hotlines on a 24/7 basis.

During 2021, QVCC's Campus Resource Team (CRT) remained active, despite challenges due to the COVID-19 pandemic. CRT would meet on a regular basis via MS Teams. QVCC's Title IX page was reviewed and updated as necessary to include all pertinent Department of Education policies and procedures related to sexual misconduct. Members of QVCC's CRT, including representatives from our third-party providers, were updated on the latest information regarding Title IX, and trained on best practices for conducting sexual misconduct investigations through SUNY's Student Conduct Institute. Although 2021 saw a slightly improved inperson presence on campus, trainings, and meetings were still conducted virtually due the COVID-19 pandemic. In addition to the Campus Resource Team holding regular meetings, 551 QVCC students completed the online sexual violence prevention training during the 2021 semester.
