

Summary of Prevention & Awareness Programming

- Green Dot Trainings: Bystander intervention training given by SHU staff
 - August 2021: RSAs, FYE Assistants, FYE Instructors
 - Approximately 200 people
 - January 2022: IFC
 - Approximately 10 people
 - March 2022: Training for one of the clubs
 - Approximately 15 people
- Domestic Abuse Awareness event: Handing out ribbons and signing a poster to raise awareness about dating/domestic violence
 - October 2021: table event
 - Approximately 50 people
- Chapter Conversations: An overview of SHU policies and procedures (Title IX and Student Conduct), and resources available
 - November 2021: All sorority chapters (except Kappa Delta)
 - Approximately 1,050 people
- Stalking Awareness: One table event discussing dangers of stalking and one having students put stalking “red dots” on a poster
 - January 2022: Two table events
 - Approximately 100 people
- White Ribbon Campaign: Delta Tau Delta hosted an event where various community members spoke to raise awareness about domestic violence and sexual assault
 - April 2022
 - Approximately 120 people
- Take Back the Night: Event on 63’s patio, writing supportive chalk messages, paper lanterns, CFJ advocate was there providing info
 - April 2022
 - Approximately 60 people
- Start by Believing: Encouraged students to take the pledge to believe survivors of dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking
 - April 2022
 - Approximately 50 people
- Consent coffee sleeves: Stickers about consent were placed on the cardboard coffee sleeves and used throughout the month of April in the market
 - April 2022
 - Another one hard to estimate but stickers went on approximately 1,000 sleeves
- Sexual Assault Awareness Art Exhibit: Hosted by the CFJ. Displayed art created by members of the larger community and displayed for four days
 - April 2022
 - Hard to estimate, the display was in a higher traffic area of West Campus so possibly 200 people
- Walk a Mile: A CFJ event to raise sexual assault awareness but we have a large student turn out
 - April 2022
 - Approximately 200-250 SHU students/staff/faculty
