



Report on Total Revenue Used as Compensation for Student-Athletes

Public Act 25-1

January 2026

We are deeply grateful for the Connecticut General Assembly's steadfast support of legislation that permits student athletes to earn compensation through endorsement contracts and revenue sharing agreements with Connecticut colleges and universities.

This important change stems from the landmark House v. NCAA settlement, which has now been implemented nationwide.
