From January 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015, the CHR-EMPS program responded to 2501 mental health emergencies involving 1880 individual children.

4

• **126** of these responses were to referrals from police departments. **107** were calls from Manchester Police through the REACT program.





- 80% of all the children referred to EMPS have experienced serious traumatic issues.
- **55%** of these traumatic experiences have involved children who were either the direct victims of physical or sexual violence, or were witnesses to domestic violence, violent deaths of friends and family members, or community violence.





Outcomes

- 78% of children referred to EMPS successfully completed treatment.
- 94% of children seen by EMPS were diverted from hospital admission.



• **75%** of children seen by EMPS were connected to additional resources within their communities.
