Domestic Violence Training Presented by Judge Barbara Bellis

- CT's recognition of serious nature of domestic violence *crimes* (criminal division)
 - Mandatory arrests
 - Risk assessments and lethality factors
 - Addressing substance and mental health issues
 - Emphasis on the court reviewing materials
 - Addressing accountability
 - -Judicial monitoring

- Assistance provided to victim and defendant
- Kinds of restrictions that may be imposed
- Duration of order

- Information provided to judges (statutorily limited)
- Assistance provided to applicant and respondent
- Findings the statute requires judges to make
- Kinds of restrictions
- Duration

- Application process
- Information provided to judges (statutorily limited)
- Assistance provided to applicant and respondent
- Findings the statute requires judges to make
- Kinds of restrictions
- Duration

Judicial Branch Recommendation

- Amend 46b-15 (family restraining order) and 46b-16a (civil orders of protection) to provide family and civil judges access to more information such as:
 - Results of a risk and lethality assessment
 - Protective/Restraining Order Registry Review
 - All criminal records
