Overarching Trend

- FIM services are NOT "going in the front door" of our health care system.
 - Barriers continue to prevent inclusion in baseline services in health insurance programs
- BUT FIM services ARE "getting in through the windows"
 - Waivers, flexibilities within individual programs, etc.

DEEPER DIVE – MEDICAID PAYMENT PATHWAYS

| Pathway | Action Required to Implement |
|---|---|
| Medicaid HCBS | State Medicaid Agency <u>submits</u> HCBS Waiver or State Plan Amendment proposal to CMS. Waiver or SPA includes FIM as covered service(s). |
| Medicaid 1115 Waiver | State Medicaid Agency <u>submits</u> 1115 Waiver proposal (or waiver amendment or renewal) to CMS. Waiver proposal includes payment for FIM service(s) |
| Managed Care: Value-Based Payment (VBP) Requirements | State Medicaid Agency requires managed care plans/providers (via contract) to use value-based payment models. State can require VBP models to address SDOH (e.g., food insecurity) and/or include CBOs Managed Care Plan/Provers implements VBP models |
| State Pilots | State legislature <u>passes</u> legislation and/or appropriation to establish a pilot program to provide FIM service(s) to Medicaid enrollees |

Medicaid Enrollees chooses to use the FIM services.



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
