PUBLIC SERVICES MOBILITY GUIDE

Purpose

The purpose of this guide is to provide the public with information and instruction regarding mobile services that are available to them.

Mobile Services

• Internet Access

Wireless Internet access is provided for the public at the Connecticut General Assembly (CGA) campus. This includes the State Capitol Building, the Legislative Office Building (LOB), and the Old State House (OSH). This wireless service is protected by virus and malware protection systems. Objectionable advertising, pornography, spyware, viruses, and other inappropriate content is blocked.

To utilize the Internet, simply connect your device to the CGA_Guest wireless network.

• Wireless Printing

Also when using the CGA_Guest wireless network, two wireless printers are available to the public. These are located in the Capitol Basement (named CAP-Basement-NorthHall and located near ITS) and the LOB first floor (named LOB-1stFloor-PublicArea and located near Capitol Police).

To print to a public wireless printer, you must be within the same building as the wireless printer to detect it. All wireless Windows devices, iOS devices version 6.0 and higher, and Android devices version 4.3 and higher should all have the capability to print to these printers.

• Web Applications

Multiple web applications have been created for use by the public. On mobile devices, they can be accessed from <u>www.cga.ct.gov</u> by selecting Mobile Web Apps from the Menu icon on the top right of the web site. They can also be accessed through the picture slideshow on the home page of the web site.
