## CONNECTICUT PRISON POPULATION STATISTICS

You asked how the prison population has changed since 1980 and 2000. You also asked how it has changed over the last several years, including the total, sentenced, and unsentenced prison population.

## SUMMARY

Since 1980, the total incarcerated population has grown from 3,845 on January 1, 1980 to 18,052 on January 1, 2010, an increase of 369.5%.

Since 2000, the total incarcerated population has grown from 17,305 on January 1, 2000 to 18,052 on January 1, 2010, an increase of 4.3%.

For the last four years, we looked at the daily incarcerated population reported by the Department of Correction. From January 1, 2006 to January 14, 2010:

- 1. the total incarcerated population varied from a low of 17,921 inmates on January 2 and 3, 2006 to a high of 19,894 inmates on February 1, 2008, with the population at 18,289 on January 14, 2010;
- 2. the sentenced inmate population varied from a low of 13,738 on January 4, 2006 to a high of 15,465 on February 8, 2008, with the population at 14,107 inmates on January 14, 2010; and

3. the unsentenced inmate population varied from a low of 4,011 on May 8, 2009 to a high of 4,777 on October 31, 2006, with the population at 4,182 inmates on January 14, 2010.

The table below displays the total incarcerated population on the  $1^{\rm st}$  of each month since January 1, 2006 and on the dates of certain events during this time period.






The charts below show the:



- 5. unsentenced incarcerated population on a daily basis from January 1, 2006 through January 14, 2010.


