Hello. I am a Seymour resident as well as a police officer in Monroe. I love my job. I love helping people, and making a difference in the community I serve. The Police Accountability Act that has been drafted will change the world of policing as we know it for officers and civilians alike. What it will do is stop the good cops, (the ones who willingly took a job with crappy pay, terrible hours, holidays worked, family events missed, and lives on the line everyday) from doing the job they wanted so badly to do. The good cops, who want to get the bad guys and who want to make a difference, won't want to take actions in situations where they aren't required to do so. I'm talking about traffic stops which lead to DUI/narcotics arrests. I'm talking about warrants not served, illegal firearms still in circulation at greater capacity. And that's just barely scratching the surface. We see what's happening already close to home. New Haven, Waterbury, Bridgeport. The crime rates have sky rocketed. Now look at New York.
